# How to join Rutland Civil Service Sailing Club

The Club provides opportunities for sailing in keelboats at Rutland Water. The Club is a corporate member of Rutland Sailing Club ("RSC") and Club members are required to abide by the RSC rules at all times.

The Club is also an affiliated member of the Civil Service Sailing Association ("CSSA") which, in turn, forms part of the Civil Service Sports Council ("CSSC").

To be a member of the Club and enjoy the benefits of being able to sail in the keelboats it is necessary to first become a member of the CSSC (and pay its annual fee) and then join the CSSA (where membership is free).

By maintaining membership of the CSSC and CSSA Club members are covered with third party liability insurance, arranged through a CSSC insurance scheme.

# 1. Joining the Civil Service Sports Council ("CSSC")

You can join the CSSC on-line by going to <a href="https://store.cssc.co.uk">https://store.cssc.co.uk</a> where you will find a "Join us" link.

Even if you are not otherwise eligible to join, you can become a "CSSC linked" member if an existing CSSC member is willing to sponsor you (in which case you will need to be able to quote their CSSC Membership number during the joining process).

Filling in the form with the required personal details and paying the prescribed fee (currently around £55) will enable an account to be set up in your name and a CSSC Membership number will be allocated to you.

## 2. Joining the Civil Service Sailing Association ("CSSA")

Having first joined the CSSC you can then join the CSSA (for free) by completing an Application form that can be downloaded from the CSSA website – the form can be downloaded from the following page: <a href="https://cs-sailing.org.uk/membership/">https://cs-sailing.org.uk/membership/</a>

## 3. Joining the Club

Having become a member of both the CSSC and CSSA you are then able to join the Rutland Civil Service Sailing Club.

This involves completing a membership application form (a copy can be downloaded from the Club's website at <a href="https://rutlandcssc.org.uk/join-rcssc">https://rutlandcssc.org.uk/join-rcssc</a>) and paying the annual subscription (currently £200).

Following receipt, you will be provided with a login and password to enable you to access the Club's website which is to be found at <a href="https://rutlandcssc.org.uk">https://rutlandcssc.org.uk</a> view the members contact list, Club rules and constitution and make bookings to participate in sailing with other Club members.

At that point, as a member of both the CSSC and CSSA and having become a member make the most of the Club's fleet of boats in accordance with the Rutland Civil Service Sailing Club rules!
